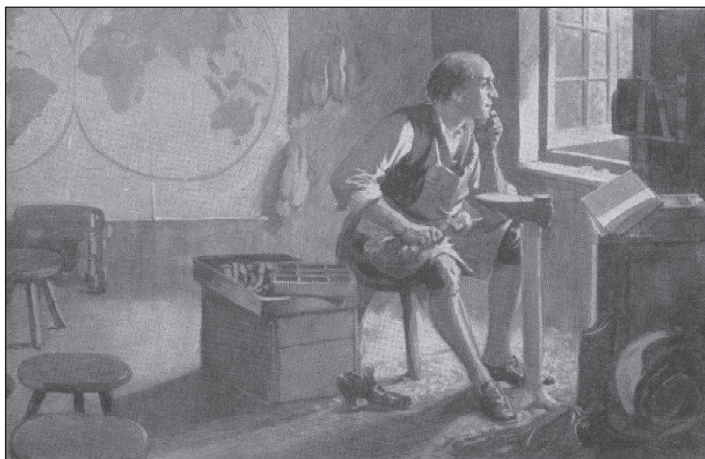


Carey 250
